**As of February 5, 2010 at 3pm Wrightsville Borough is declaring a snow emergency. The snow emergency is in effect until February 7, 2010 at 2PM. Motor vehicle traffic on Borough streets and alleys such as would hinder snow removal and emergency operations is hereby prohibited except in instances of personal emergency. Depositing or throwing snow upon or into any Borough street or alley is hereby prohibited.**

## DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on or about 2/5/2010 a winter storm (disaster) has caused or threatens to cause injury, damage, and suffering to the persons and property of Wrightsville Borough and

WHEREAS, the winter storm (disaster) has endangered the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in Wrightsville Borough and threatens to create problems greater in scope than Wrightsville Borough may be able to resolve, and;

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents in Wrightsville Borough;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, the undersigned Mayor of Wrightsville Borough pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 PA C.S., Section 7501), as amended, do hereby declare the existence of a disaster emergency in Wrightsville Borough.

FURTHER, I direct the Borough Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services, and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this emergency.

STILL FURTHER, I authorize officials of Wrightsville Borough to act as necessary to meet the current exigencies of this emergency, namely: by the employment of temporary workers, by the rental of equipment, by the purchase of supplies and materials, and by entering into such contracts and agreements for the performance of public work as may be required to meet the emergency, all without regard to those time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, mandatory constitutional requirements excepted.

This Declaration shall take effect immediately.
