Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 6:31PM by Chairwoman Englehart.

Baseball/Softball Update

There are still a few trophy name plates that need to be distributed and there are a few uniforms still outstanding.

Brent Graybill presented the board with an idea of a baseball clinic to be held in early spring(April) or late summer (July/August) 2012. The baseball clinic would cater to each skill; i.e., pitching, batting, fielding (infield and outfield). Donations would be sought and about 5-10 volunteers would be needed to run the clinic. There would be a nominal fee to participate with a maximum of 45-50 children able to be accommodated. The baseball clinic would be open to any child in the Eastern York area. The clinic would run for 3 hours for 5 nights. On the 5th night, there would be awards and a scrimmage. Sponsors would also be sought for t-shirts.

D. Livelsberger stated if there is an interest that the WRC should begin moving on the clinic by the end of basketball season. D. Livelsberger also inquired as to whether the borough would cover the liability insurance for such an event. C. Bolton to check and get back at the next meeting.

Basketball Update

The gym request has been sent, no word yet as to approval. There are still uniforms outstanding from previous years. C. Bolton to create flyer for distribution throughout Eastern York School District. E. Smith asked that a line giving the WRC email address and his cell phone number be added to the flyer. Cost is \$55/player with \$5 being deducted for each additional player.

E. Smith informed the board that there is currently no president and secretary for EYC Basketball and that he did not know when the next EYC meeting was going to be held.

Fundraising Update

There will be a mandatory fundraiser for basketball. Money will be due at the time of sign-up. Fundraiser is a Meat Lottery. The lottery will run from Nov. 7th – Dec 1st. Tickets will have two numbers on them and the 3-digit Monday and Thursday daily number will be used to determine the winner. Winners on Mondays will receive a Winter Bundle from Sue's Market and Thursday winners will receive a Steak Bundle. Average value of the bundles is \$60. Tickets cost \$5/piece and each household will be required to purchase five tickets to sell. C. Bolton will create a sheet explaining the fundraiser to parents.

L. Cunningham will contact Hoss's about doing a Community Night fundraiser in October.

WRC will participate in a pancake breakfast fundraiser with the Masonic Lodge. Tentative date is February 18, 2012. E. Smith to ask for a "no play" date for basketball so the players can participate in the fundraiser. WRC may possibly team with the Masonic Lodge for a car wash in the spring.

Activities for Bridge Bust are yet to be determined. Suggestion of doing a BBQ with the WFD was made.

Bus trip netted a profit of \$175. Two WRC backpacks and one WRC t-shirt were given away as door prizes on the bus. If a bus trip is conducted in the future, there need to be two contact people. The call volume was too demanding for one person to handle.

Other Business

Columbia co-ed softball requested to use the riverfront fields on September 1st. Approval was granted.
