May 31, 2011

Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 6:35PM by Chairwoman Englehart.

In attendance were:

J. Englehart, L. Cunningham and C. Eckman. Not in attendance was D. Livelsberger (E) and E. Smith (E).

Motion to approve the minutes was made by L. Cunningham and seconded by C. Eckman. Motion to approve the check register was made by J. Englehart and seconded by C. Eckman.

Public Comment

S. Young stated WRC should have/could have charged more for the breakfast sandwiches at Heritage Day. Sandwiches were a hit with the vendors.

Treasurer/Concession Update

Heritage Day was a success with all chicken dinners being sold. WRC netted approximately \$350 after paying Big Bob's BBQ for chicken dinners. Three (3) flats of eggs, three (3) lbs. of bacon, 1 ½ lbs. of ham and four (4) loaves of bread were used for breakfast; however, the orange juice did not sell.

J. Englehart continues to have problems finding sufficient assistance at the concession stand. Must find volunteers that are willing to work in the concession stand or stand will not be open. J. Englehart has been speaking to various individuals about serving on the WRC.

Baseball/Softball Update

A date of July 13 (rain date July 20) was set for the end-of-season picnic. E. Smith to speak with Brent Graybill about utilizing Masonic Hall for picnic. If Masonic Hall must be rented, picnic will be held at the riverfront park instead. Postcards to be sent upon confirmation of location. Picnic to be held from 6-8PM and uniforms are to be turned in at that time or trophy will be held until uniform is returned.

Discussion ensued regarding use of the elementary school fields for next year's baseball/t-ball season. Modifications to the fields need to be made to accommodate teams.

If Vine Street fields are to be utilized next year, the concession stand needs electricity and running water. It is unsanitary to run stand without electric and water. Stand also needs to be within sight line of the fields. Vine Street fields also need to be handicap accessible.

Livelsberger to speak to the Wrightsville Social Club and explain that

the WRC took a huge loss this year due to the weather and not being able to open concession stand. He will ask if they are still willing to donate funds.

Fundraising Update

Flyers will be distributed to the Eastern York School District in coming days regarding the baseball trip. L. Cunningham stated the Seagraves Club would like to purchase two (2) tickets to be given to a father/son, mother/son, etc. who would like to go on the bus trip but cannot afford the tickets. Thank you letter will be sent upon purchase of the tickets.

L. Cunningham to research the possibility of the WRC collecting Capri Sun/Koolaid pouches to be turned in for cash. C. Bolton to contact Sue's Market and Wrightsville Elementary about placing collection bins for the pouches at these locations.

L. Cunningham stated the Ladies Auxiliary from the Legion would like to share the WRC space during Bridge Bust to conduct a bake/rummage sale. J. Englehart stated that this is ultimately up to the borough, not the WRC. Formal discussions regarding Bridge Bust will begin in July. J. Englehart would like to see a menu from Big Bob's BBQ. C. Bolton to forward menu.

WRC will conduct a Hoss's Fundraising Night on August 18 and an Isaac's Fundraising Night on August 25. Flyers will be given to the players at the end-of-season picnic.

Other Business

Discussion ensued about basketball signups and how to get players/parents to participate in fundraising. Parents will be charged at registration for the mandatory fundraiser and be issued a refund if they participate. J. Englehart requested a more in-depth registration form be acquired as our current forms are inadequate. C. Bolton to research and forward ideas to WRC for thoughts. Discussion also ensued regarding installment payments for registrations.

Motion to adjourn was made at 7:45PM by C. Eckman and seconded by L. Cunningham.
