

Wrightsville Recreation Commission
December 29, 2009
Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 6:33PM by J. Englehart.

In attendance were:

Motion to approve the minutes was made by J. Copulos and seconded by D. Neff. Motion to approve the check register was made by C. Eckman and seconded by J. Copulos.

Treasurer/Concession Update

J. Englehart will check stand for supplies prior to purchasing any food products for the quarter auction on February 6, 2010. J. Englehart also has change set aside for the quarter auction.

Baseball/Softball Update

Sign-ups will most likely take place the last weekend of January. Fliers need to be printed and sent to the school for approval prior to being distributed. D. Neff to give D. Livelsberger pertinent information. Sign-up fee will remain \$50 for first child/\$45 for second. D. Livelsberger mentioned a possible league fee increase from EYC. This would be the "per person" fee. D. Livelsberger is expecting it to be minimal.

D. Livelsberger informed the board that when he went to shut off the H2O in the concession stand he realized the fridge is no longer working. All food products that were in the refrigerator were disposed of. Chest freezer is still working fine. Search to begin for a replacement refrigerator.

Basketball Update

Younger kids have started their games. Older kids will begin their games on January 2, 2010.

The biggest issues facing basketball this year are parents parking in the circle at the school and unattended siblings of players running loose in the school and on the stage in the gym.

D. Neff turned in an invoice of \$100.50 for coaches shirts. E. Sipes to place invoice in his mailbox for borough secretary to pay.

A refund will be issued to the parents of Jazmyne Hunter for sign-up fees due to suffering a stroke. A collection was taken up at basketball practices and \$120+ and a stuffed bear were to be given to Jazmyne's parents on behalf of the Wrightsville Recreation Commission & basketball players/parents/coaches. C. Bolton also mentioned the possibility of "comping" any sign-up fees for the next year for Jazmyne and Jordyn Hunter. Motion to refund sign-up fees to the Hunter family was made by C. Bolton and seconded by E. Smith.

Sign Update

All signs have been brought up from garage area; however, there is nowhere to put them. Signs also need to be cleaned-up. C. Eckman will formulate a list of all businesses that have signs and send them renewal forms. C. Bolton gave C. Eckman labeled envelopes to send along with the renewal forms.

Fundraising Update

A sub sale from Sue's Market will take place beginning Monday, January 4, 2010 and end on Wednesday, January 21, 2010. Distribution will take place on Thursday, January 28, 2010 at the EY Sr. Center from 4-5:30PM.

The quarter auction will be held on Saturday, February 6, 2010 at Locust Street UM Church's social hall from 1-3PM. Doors will open at 12PM. 200 paddles will be sold at a cost of \$4/piece or three (3)/\$10. Vendors to date are Pampered Chef, The Green Candle Store, Avon, Mary Kay and Cookie Lee. C. Bolton and J. Englehart are going to continue to solicit vendors for the quarter auction. C. Bolton to contact the WFD and ask to use some of the tables as LSUMC does not have enough. Food items to be sold are soft pretzels, soda, water, coffee, hot dogs/sauerkraut, beef bbq, chicken corn soup, "rice krispie" treats and other baked goods. A sign will be made with prices closer to the time of the auction. Donations are being sought from various businesses for raffle prizes. Donations from John Wright and Dutch Apple Dinner Theatre have already been received. L. Cunningham to take care of advertising on community calendars such as WGAL, WARM 103, Fox 43, 98.5 The Peak, 96.1 WSOX and the Merchandiser. C. Bolton created a flier for placement in Wrightsville.

Talk of partnering with Historic Wrightsville for Heritage Days on Memorial Day weekend commenced. The board members suggested J. Englehart report back at the January meeting regarding Historic Wrightsville's expectations from the WRC.

Other Business

Motion to appoint J. Englehart chair of the WRC was made by D. Livelsberger and seconded by C. Eckman. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion to appoint J. Copulos vice chair of the WRC was made by C. Bolton and seconded by D. Neff. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion to bring Sharon Young's name before borough council for appointment to WRC was made by J. Copulos and seconded by D. Neff. Motion passed with majority vote.

Motion to adjourn was made at 7:46PM by C. Bolton and seconded by D. Neff.
