175th Anniversary post was corrected and \$54 was credited back to WRC checking account.

Concession Stand Update

Total profit for the 2009 season was \$1231.54. There are a few food items left from the season; i.e. nacho chips, cheese, freeze pops and candy bars. These items will be used at the sports picnic on August 13. J. Englehart is requesting the water not be shut off until after the August 13 picnic in case we need to do any dishes. C. Bolton will notify D. Livelsberger of this request. L. Cunningham will contact River's Beverage about possible donation of soda for picnic, C. Bolton will donate a box or two of "Hugs" drinks and J. Englehart will pick up burgers, hot dogs and rolls from Sue's Market.

C. Bolton questioned the possibility of opening an account w/ Sue's Market for food purchases. J. Englehart stated this is something can be done and whenever we would like to "close out" the account, Sue is to be notified and we will be billed. C. Bolton also questioned the possibility of getting a BJ's or Sam's Club membership for the WRC. The question was brought up if this is something the borough could do for us or not. C. Bolton will research costs associated with getting memberships and a charge card from both clubs and see if this is a cost-effective and viable idea.

Baseball/Softball Update

The season is over. Trophies have been ordered for the August 13 picnic. The cost for the trophies is approximately \$5/piece for a total of about \$275. The uniforms (jerseys and pants) will be collected at the picnic as well. The visitors dugout has been damaged and a police report has been filed. The water to the concession stand will be shut off after the picnic. A thank you letter has been sent to Mr. Robert Urey for the replacement of the dugout roof.

Basketball Update

D. Neff sent the paperwork back to WES for gym time and the fliers have been sent to the school for approval. A sub sale with Sue's Market will be conducted in conjunction with basketball signups.

Sign Update

C. Eckman needs to know the size and depth of the table we will be purchasing in order to have a banner printed for the WRC. It was decided that we will purchase an 8' table for use.

Signs will be removed after the August 13 picnic.

Fundraiser Update

L. Cunningham will be placing the Gianni's order on July 31. Pick up time to be announced after order placement.

C. Bolton will research Sheetz coupon books for a possible future fundraiser. Information was given regarding quarter auctions. C. Bolton and L. Cunningham to look into what is involved in conducting a quarter auction with hopes of WRC conducting one in the winter.

C. Bolton will be sending a letter to the EY school board regarding a possible donation to the WRC next year.

Other Business

WRC will be setting up a stand at the October 2009 Bridge Bust.

C. Eckman will inventory all equipment and sort uniforms by size once all items have been collected. C. Eckman has been diligently organizing and cleaning the garage.

Due to absence from more than two meetings, P. Shue has been removed from the WRC. There are now two (2) open seats on the WRC. If anyone knows of any interested parties, names are to be brought to the next meeting.

E. Sipes is still conducting his investigation into the equipment and Grove's Sporting Goods issue. Report expected at August meeting.

Picture of the proposed trophy case must be presented to the Municipal Authority for their approval.

J. Copulos informed the members that he would not be in attendance at the August meeting due to a conference he will be attending out of state.

Motion to adjourn was made by D. Neff and seconded by J. Copulos. Meeting was adjourned at 7:39PM.
