Treasurer's Report

Concession Stand Update

May 2, 2009 - \$50; May 13, 2009 - \$35; May 20, 2009 - \$99; May 21, 2009 - \$133. The May 24, 2009, pig roast brought in a total of \$876. After expenses, the profit was \$511.75. 3 ½ bags of pork were left over

and will be sold at the concession stand. A deposit of \$1009 was made on May 26, 2009.

C. Bolton will run concession stand on May 31 from 1:30-3:30PM; D. Neff will run stand from 3:30PM-5:30PM for t-ball games. There are still no volunteers to staff the stand when softball has home games.

Baseball/Softball Update

D. Livelsberger indicated the need for more lime. Invoice received from EYC for baseball fees. A refund is to be issued to two (2) softball players (One medical reason, one too young for team). 11-13 will be using the school field next year. B. McKee to speak with Pepsi about possibility of sponsoring a new scoreboard and a possible fountain soda contract.

C. Eckman indicated that nine (9) signs have been renewed and paid in full and there are two (2) signs pending (Grove's Sporting Goods & Casa D'Oria). The SAL has purchased a new sign for \$250. C. Bolton to email C. Eckman the WRC logo for use on a sign to be put up when the WRC does the Bridge Bust, etc.
