

Wrightsville Recreation Commission
October 27, 2009
Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 6:32pm by Vice Chairman Englehart.

L. Cunningham (E) was not present. Motion to approve the September minutes was made by C. Eckman and seconded by J. Copulos. Motion to approve the check register was made by D. Neff and seconded by C. Eckman.

J. Copulos indicated he would not be present for November's meeting.

Public Comment

Chris Leiphart, formerly of Wrightsville Youth Sports Association, asked the WRC members to consider conducting a fundraiser to pay two outstanding invoices to Donnie Knaub for miscellaneous clothing and medals. The invoices, dated October 2007 and March 2008, are for a total of \$835. After Chris left, the board commenced discussion and agreed that since the bills were not incurred by the WRC, we are not liable for these invoices. A letter will be drafted to C. Leiphart and brought before the board at the November meeting for approval.

Jeff and Darlena Ringley, The Green Candle Store, gave a candle fundraising presentation. The Green Candle Store makes soy candles in over 200 fragrances/40 colors. The customer can choose their fragrance and color thereby customizing their candle to their liking. For every candle over \$9.99 sold, the WRC would receive \$5. For any candle under \$9.99, the WRC would receive \$3. Turnaround time on the candles is approximately two weeks. Orders can be placed online and the WRC will be assigned a coupon code in order to receive credit for orders placed via internet. The board members decided to conduct a candle fundraiser for basketball commencing Monday, November 2, and ending Friday,

November 19, 2009. Candles will be available for pickup on Thursday, December 17 at the borough council chambers.

Treasurer's Report/Concession Stand Update

J. Englehart and C. Bolton attended the budget workshop on Monday, October 26, 2009 and presented the 2010 WRC budget. C. Bolton to forward K. Brenner 2010 projected income as soon as possible.

There are pretzels left over from Bridge Bust. They are in the freezer at the concession stand and are for sale for .75/piece. Anyone interested in purchasing pretzels are to contact J. Englehart.

Baseball/Softball Update

There's been no word on the repair of the dugout. It is still up in the air as to who is responsible for payment of said repair. E. Sipes to look into this matter.

There is a good possibility we will not need diamatex for the 2010 season. E. Sipes to speak with B. McKee regarding getting the diamatex covered for winter.

D. Livelsberger to begin documenting the date, time started/ended and work performed on any and all fields by WRC members.

There is a fall softball game scheduled for Sunday, November 1, 2009 at 2:00PM. Volunteers needed to run concession stand.

E. Sipes to work with Brian Lyle regarding baseball field drainage issue.

Basketball Update

Sign-ups have ended. There are currently three (3) K-2 teams, three (3) 3rd-4th grade boys' teams, one (1) 3rd-6th grade girls' team, two (2) 5th-8th grade boys' teams and two (2) 7th-10th grade girls' teams. However, there are currently only four (4) girls signed up for the 3rd-6th grade team. At least three (3) more girls are needed to have a complete team. If we cannot come up with the additional girls, we will need to forfeit ten (10) games at \$28/piece.

D. Neff indicated Erik Smith, basketball coach, has shown a willingness to be on the WRC. E. Sipes to present E. Smith's name to council on November 2, 2009, for approval. Motion to approve Erik Smith's name for recommendation to borough council was made by D. Neff and seconded by C. Eckman.

Sign/Garage Update

C. Eckman informed the WRC members that the sign for Sue's Market cost \$235 with the WRC realizing a \$15 profit; the sign for the SAL is smaller than Sue's (3'x4') and a profit of \$30 was realized on that sign.

Sign renewal letters will be sent out at the same time as baseball/softball sign-ups. C. Eckman to have count to C. Bolton in order to have labels/envelopes ready at appropriate time.

C. Eckman asked if E. Sipes could have all signs brought up to the WRC garage for sorting and proper storage. Additionally, all sports supplies need to be in one place for easy access and inventory.

Fundraiser Update

Sheetz coupon monies will be due at the November meeting. J. Englehart indicated she will take any coupons that other WRC members are having trouble selling.

Total profit from the Sue's sub sale was \$715.25.

Other Business

Motion to adjourn was made by D. Neff and seconded by C. Bolton. Meeting was adjourned at 8:44PM.
