Motion to approve the August minutes was made by D. Neff and seconded by C. Eckman providing two (2) minor spelling corrections be made on pages 2 & 3. Motion to approve the check register was made by C. Bolton and seconded by D. Neff.

Treasurer's Report

J. Englehart is in receipt of Sam's Club membership card. It was decided that the WRC will maintain only one (1) membership card for the time being. If, in the future, it is necessary to get another card, we will do so.

If an account is open at Sue's Market, J. Englehart is in charge of picking up receipts and presenting at next regularly scheduled WRC meeting. Payment to Sue's will also be dropped off personally by J. Englehart. This will save us postage. Latest bill with Sue's Market will be closed out after Bridge Bust on Saturday, October 3, 2009.

Any receipts from Sam's Club will be scanned into computer and emailed directly to Missi Bisking, borough secretary, in order to get receipts in to borough office promptly for payment.

Concession Stand Update

L. Cunningham purchased two (2) boxes of soft pretzels from BJ's for concession stand because Sam's Club did not have any in stock. A reimbursement will show up on the check register for this purchase.

A gas grill was donated to the WRC by Bill and Patti Harr. C. Bolton to send a thank you letter.

Discussion commenced regarding the purchase of a Foreman Grill for use at the concession stand. Grill has a 72" square cooking surface and has 3 removable plates. Cost is \$55 through QVC. L. Cunningham will check into possible invoicing for payment. Motion to approve the purchase of the Foreman grill was made by J. Copulos and seconded by C. Eckman.

Baseball/Softball Update

There are a few uniforms still outstanding. D. Livelsberger will be following up with players.

Fall softball game scheduled for Sunday, October 4. D. Livelsberger to work concession stand for this game.

D. Livelsberger tried to push cinder block back into place on the dugout; however, the cinder block is now crumbling. B. McKee gave an estimate to E. Sipes to fix the dugout. WRC needs to know who is in charge of paying to fix the dugout.

Maintenance of the fields was discussed and agreed that the borough is taking better care of the field where the weeds are concerned.

All baseball and softball meetings were attended for EYC.

Basketball Update

Last basketball sign-up will take place on Wednesday, September 30, 2009 at the borough council chambers from 6-8PM. D. Neff stated that there will be MS/HS stragglers after school basketball tryouts are over. Teams and rosters for older kids are not due until the end of December.

Practices are tentatively scheduled to begin the 3rd week of October. Games for the younger kids will begin at the end of December; games for the older kids will begin after the holidays.

Sign Update

C. Eckman located the Electroplaters sign. Jake Graham will return the sign to proper person. The sign for Keith Brenner has not been located yet; however, there are signs behind the Wrightsville Municipal Authority building. C. Eckman will move them into the garage when there is room for them. J. Englehart suggested a WRC clean-up day in the garage.

C. Eckman is in receipt of the banner for on the table. Banner will be attached to the table for the Bridge Bust on Saturday, October 3.

Field signs will be removed at the conclusion of fall ball.

Fundraiser Update

Sheetz coupon sale will commence on Wednesday, September 30, 2009. Coupons are \$4 a piece with \$1.50 coming back to the WRC. 17 books were ordered and distributed to WRC members. WRC has two months to sell all coupons.

C. Bolton asked if the members would be willing to have a representative from the "Green Candle Store" give a presentation at the October meeting in hopes of conducting a soy candle fundraiser between Thanksgiving and Christmas. All members agreed. C. Bolton to schedule presentation.

Sue's sub sale orders are due by Wednesday, October 7, 2009. Sorting and sub pickup will take place at the Eastern York Senior Center on Thursday, October 15, 2009. Sorting will begin at 3:30PM with pickup scheduled from 4:30-5:30PM.

Bridge Bust schedule is as follows: J. Englehart, L. Cunningham and C. Bolton - 8AM-12PM; J. Copulos - 11AM-1PM; D. Livelsberger and D. Neff - 1-3PM. Coffee will be added to the menu at a cost of \$.50 per cup. L. Cunningham will supply the coffee, creamer and sugar. L. Cunningham to dice/slice onions for hamburgers & hot dogs. D. Neff will order soft pretzels from Philadelphia Pretzel Company. Cost is \$.72 per 100 ordered. 100 pretzels will be ordered. Pretzels will be sold for \$1.25. D. Neff indicated we will not be invoiced for the pretzels; therefore, a reimbursement to D. Neff will also show up on the check register. L. Cunningham will ask to use electric from the VFW. C. Bolton to contact the WFD and ask if we can get ice from the fire station for the coolers.
