

## Wrightsville Recreation Commission

November 24, 2009

### Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 6:40PM by C. Bolton.

In attendance were:

C. Bolton, J. Englehart (late arrival), D. Neff, E. Smith, D. Livelsberger and C. Eckman. L. Cunningham (UE) and J. Copulos (E) were not present.

Motion to approve the minutes was made by D. Neff and seconded by D. Livelsberger. Motion to approve the check register was made by D. Neff and seconded by D. Livelsberger.

All members were given a draft of a letter to Chris Leiphart regarding assistance paying outstanding invoices from WYSA. Motion to approve the letter as written was made by C. Eckman and seconded by D. Neff. Letter to be sent to C. Leiphart by borough secretary.

#### **Treasurer/Concession Update**

D. Neff is awaiting cash payment for basketball signups for two of the players and is waiting to hear from the parent of the other player.

There are still soft pretzels for sale in the concession stand for \$.75/piece.

#### **Baseball/Softball Update**

The last fall ball game was cancelled due to field conditions. Per D. Livelsberger, we will probably not participate in fall ball next year because the weather is too unpredictable.

Bats and supplies were donated to WRC by Roxanne Strine. Thank you letter will be sent once address is located for Mrs. Strine. Totes are needed for the uniforms as they are currently being stored in boxes.

Water still has not been turned off in the concession stand; however, this will be taken care of in the next week or so.

#### **Basketball Update**

Refunds have been mailed to the third to sixth grade girls. K-6<sup>th</sup> games have been scheduled and will begin in December. Final counts are due on December 1, 2009. The jerseys that were ordered will be in next week.

We currently need volunteers to help set-up/clean-up on Saturday, December 19, 2009. Set-up begins at 8:00AM with games beginning at 9:00AM. Games in December end by 12PM. January/February games run until 4:00PM.

D. Neff has an invoice for Grove's Sporting Goods to be turned in to the borough secretary for payment.

C. Bolton will call Youth Sports Photo Inc. to schedule basketball pictures for Tuesday, January 12 at 6:00PM.

### **Sign Update**

Signs still need to be brought up to the garage. Bob was asked to bring the signs up; however, after discussion between E. Sipes and C. Eckman, the signs will be brought up by Ed and Chet.

C. Eckman will clean the signs and take inventory. Signs can be reused if business no longer needs/wants the sign.

C. Eckman is trying to clean up the garage; however, the tractor is in the way. Discussion commenced regarding refurbishing the tractor for use (new tires and battery needed). The WRC will try to have a spring clean-up day in the garage to try to bring about some order. Shelves are needed to store items.

C. Bolton suggested enlisting the boy scouts or an Eagle Scout to perform this service.

### **Fundraising Update**

The candle sale netted \$385 profit. Candles will be distributed on December 17. Candle sale could have been more successful had all teams participated. The idea of having coaches designate a team parent to assist with fundraising was discussed. Coaches need to participate in the fundraising in order for the WRC to be successful.

Sheetz coupon money is due on November 24, 2009. Invoice to be paid by December 4, 2009. Borough secretary has the invoice already.

C. Bolton shared information regarding possibly conducting a pasta fundraiser in the spring. E. Smith to take to the parents on his basketball team and get their input as to pursuing this type of fundraiser. C. Bolton suggested possibly making up a questionnaire to give to parents at sign-ups regarding types of fundraisers to participate with in the future.

C. Bolton mentioned the possibility of having a WRC yard sale in the spring and asking residents to donate unwanted, usable items for us to sell. The WRC could have the yard sale at the baseball fields and rent spaces to any other residents/vendors who are interested in participating. C. Bolton also mentioned L. Kirkessner's idea of selling vendor spots on the sidewalk up Hellam St. and S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street for Bridge Bust.

J. Englehart suggested WRC team up with Historic Wrightsville for future community events as HW is looking for assistance. Heritage Day is going to be moved to the Saturday before Memorial Day in 2010 and will be held at John Wright.

The WRC will hold a quarter auction on Saturday, February 6 from 1-3PM. E. Sipes to request use of the Sr. Center. Paddles will be sold for \$4/piece or 3/\$10. WRC will sell food and have baskets for raffle. C. Bolton to work on letters to be sent to vendors for donations of raffle items. J. Englehart, C. Bolton and D. Neff will work on contacting vendors to participate in the event.

Motion to adjourn was made at 8:27PM by D. Neff and seconded by J. Englehart.
