**Baseball Update**

Fliers distributed for signups to all elementary schools, middle school and high school. Signups will be Friday, February 13 & February 20 from 6-8PM and Saturday, February 14 & February 21 from 10-12PM.

Two pitching machines are to be purchased at a cost of \$600-700/piece. Capabilities of the machines include: ability to pitch softballs and baseballs, grounders, pop-ups, adjustable speeds. Machines are portable and manual feed. Electric will need to be run in order to utilize the machines on the fields. Purchase of cages for the machines was conducted. Due to limited storage space, purchase of cages will wait.

The possibility of a 14-16 year-old baseball team exists within the Susquehanna League. There are currently five (5) kids interested in playing in this age group.

A date for the End-of-the-Year awards picnic was set for Thursday, August 13, 2009 (raindate: August 20, 2009) at the pavilion by the baseball fields. Players with the last names A-K to bring a dessert and players with the last names L-Z to bring a side dish/salad to share. WRC to supply hamburgers/hot dogs, rolls, drinks and place settings.

### **Concession Stand Update**
